COME, HOLY SPIRIT...

Father, I come to You in the name of Jesus. I confess that intimidation has too often caused me to fear, falter, shrink back, and turn away from what You have called me to do, as I consider what is against me.

Forgive me for anytime I have given my attention to what is not pure, not good, not righteous. Forgive me for thinking that You have made me inferior to the enemy or that You have left me powerless to meet and defeat him. Forgive me for thinking that I have been left alone. I had forgotten for a moment that I am loved and forgiven by You and because of the cross and the shed blood of Christ, I have, therefore, been made right with You. I had forgotten for a moment that You have overcome the world. Because of that knowledge, I do not need to give in to fear, intimidation, anxiety or panic.

Therefore, I refuse, reject, and rebuke any spirit of fear and intimidation. Holy Spirit, come and fill me with boldness and fortitude. I receive from You a sound mind. Heal me and cleanse my mind from a poverty mentality. Replace it with a Kingdom mindset. The Spirit, the Holy Spirit who is God, will empower me to think and make decisions with the mind of Christ, and I am made ready, by His power, to live my life gaining ground for the Kingdom of God. Thank You, Lord Jesus, for Your faithfulness to me. Thank You for giving me the gift of the Spirit. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Come, Holy Spirit. Sweep over my mind and my heart. Come, Holy Spirit, and fill every crack and crevice. I honor You, Lord Jesus, as Prince of Peace. Come and make Yourself known to me, in me, and through me as the Prince of Peace. I ask for, and by faith I receive, Your peace in my body, soul, and spirit. Come fill me with Your peace. In the midst of troubling circumstances, Jesus, I ask that You shoe my feet with the gospel of peace. I want to stand rooted securely in You as I face opposition and persecution. I will not be moved. Prince of Peace, come and fill me with Your peace. In Jesus' name, Amen.
