

Salvation Prayer

If Jesus is knocking on the door of your heart right now, pray this prayer:

Father, in the name of Jesus, I thank You for awakening me to my need of salvation.

I thank You for convicting me of my sins and that I am a sinner who needs forgiveness.

I thank You for the godly sorrow You have brought into my soul to draw me to Jesus.

I do not ask You to forgive me because of anything good I have done or will do after today.

I am asking You to forgive my sins not on the basis of my self-righteousness, but on the basis of Jesus' righteousness.

I believe You will forgive me because of Jesus' death on the cross for my sins.

Jesus, I thank You for dying for me.

Holy Spirit, I thank You for convicting me and drawing me to Jesus.

Almighty God, hear my confession.

Take a moment to ask God to forgive you of specific sins that have caused you sorrow, regret, or hurt, or perhaps have hurt others. Whatever God brings to your memory, confess it as sin and ask for forgiveness. Do not rush this moment. When you are done confessing the sins that come to your mind, then you can proceed to the prayer below.

Thank You, Father.

Thank You, Jesus.

Thank You, Holy Spirit.

Thank You for hearing my prayer.

Thank you for forgiving my sins

Thank you for giving me eternal life.

I commit my life to You.

Give me the power of Your Holy Spirit; enable me to live for Your honor and glory.



Fill me with Your Spirit.

Cause Your gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow into my life. Teach me how to hear from You.

Teach me how to follow the leading of Your Spirit.

In Jesus' name, amen.

So, what should you do now? First, find a good Bible-believing Church that welcomes the presence and gifts of the Holy Spirit. Be baptized and become an active part of that church, remembering that you have gifts that God wants to release through you to others in that local body, as well as in and through your life wherever you live and work.

Read your Bible, pray, and meditate on scriptures. Share your faith with others, and reveal God's love and compassion to others. Share this book with others. Study the different chapters, until you can talk about the reasons Jesus died on the cross to others. Become a friend of Jesus for life!
